Accomplishments Year-to-Date

- Developed our Technology Plan with an implementation plan.
- Signed Canvas access agreement with OTAN
- CASAS eTest, completed proctor and coordinator online trainings and submitted online agreement with CASAS
- Two rooms set up for HiSet/GED testing with online proctor

Setback

- Our Admissions and Testing Coordinator has been out for several months due to surgeries which delayed completing the online CASAS trainings for eTests.



Next Steps

- Finish purchasing \$50,000 in technology equipment from the awarded CDE grant and install equipment



- Complete teacher & staff CASAS eTest proctor on-line training
- Develop procedures for administering eTesting
- Schedule staff Canvas in person training this summer with OTAN staff.


Other areas of importance & relevance
