

• <u>Big wig</u>: An important person or famous person.





- <u>Business before pleasure:</u> This expression means that it is considered preferable to finish one's work before going to relax and enjoy oneself.







- Lemon: A defective product, or anything that doesn't work very well; something which breaks constantly.






- Bite the hand that feeds you: To be ungrateful, to turn against your family or employer or other supporters.
- Tomorrow is another day: that even if everything is not satisfactory at present, there will be opportunity for things to improve.


