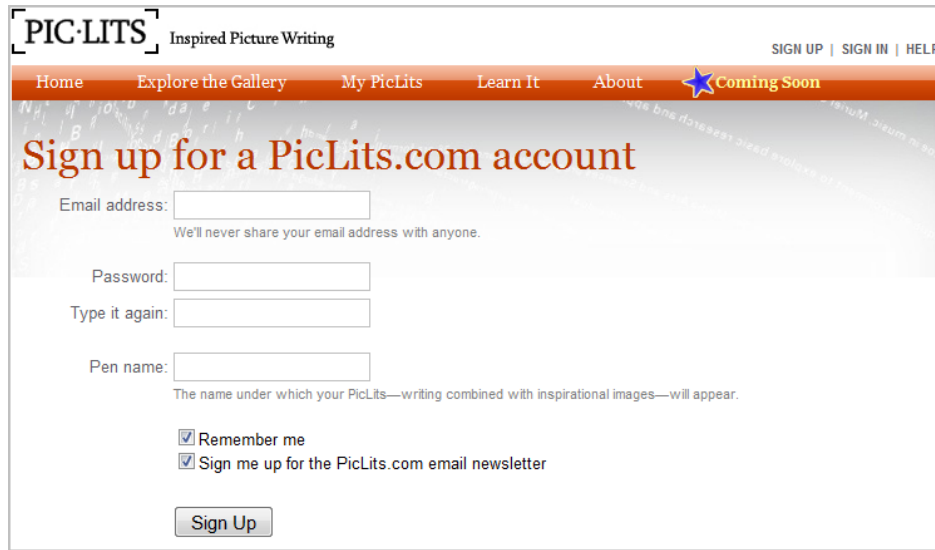


Instructions for PicLits

1. Go to <http://www.piclits.com/>
2. Click “Sign Up” and fill out the registration form.

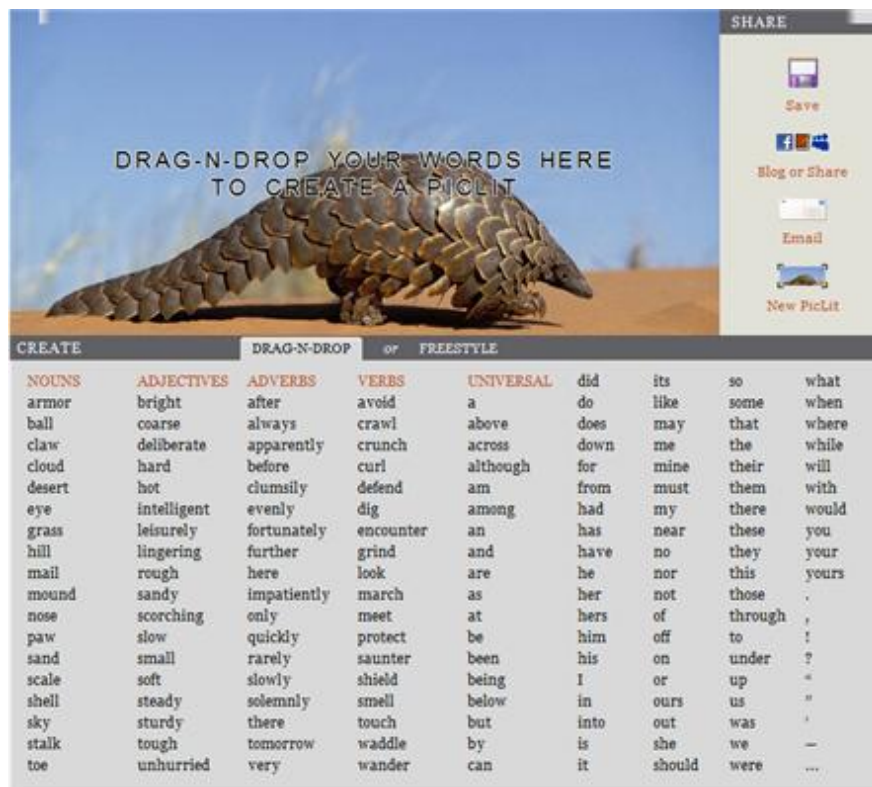

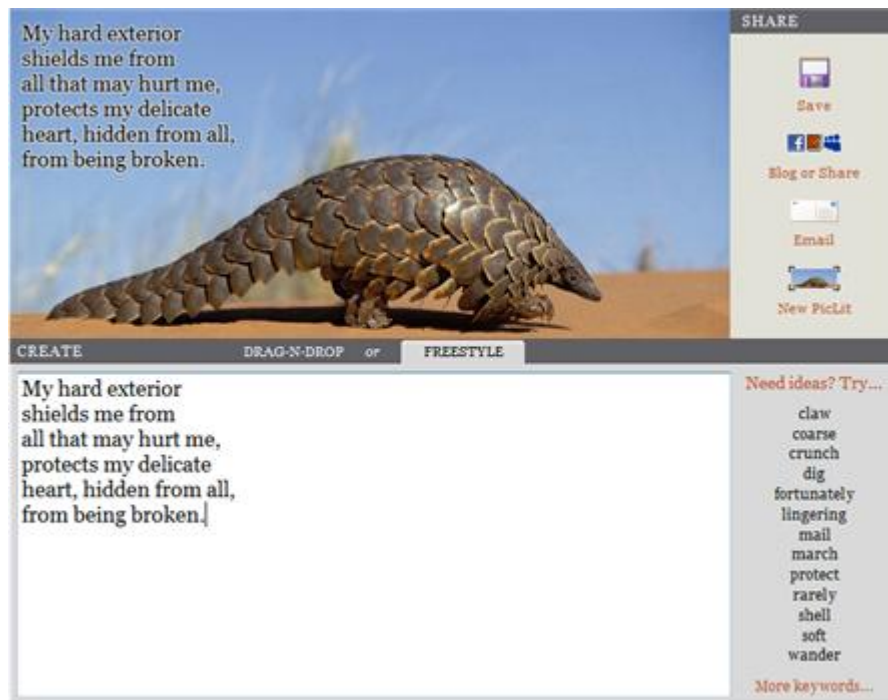

To change a word in the Drag-n-Drop mode (conjugate a verb or choose a different tense, choose a different part of speech, or capitalize the first letter), click the down arrow to the right of the word. and make your selected change by clicking on it)



or click "Freestyle" to type words on the image.



5. Click "Save" to save the PicLit to your account and to the site Gallery.

6. To share a saved PicLit, sign in to your account and click "My PicLits." Click on the PicLit you want to share. To send a link to the URL for a PicLit in the body of an email message, click "Email it" and enter the recipient's address and a short message and click "Send."
