

Analogies

An analogy is made up of two pairs of related words. The relationship between the two pairs is the same in both sets. The first pair is an example. Use that relationship in completing the second set.

Horse: farm (object: location) stove: kitchen

Finger: hand (part: whole) eye: face

Sad: unhappy (synonym) happy: glad

Tall: short (antonym) happy: sad
