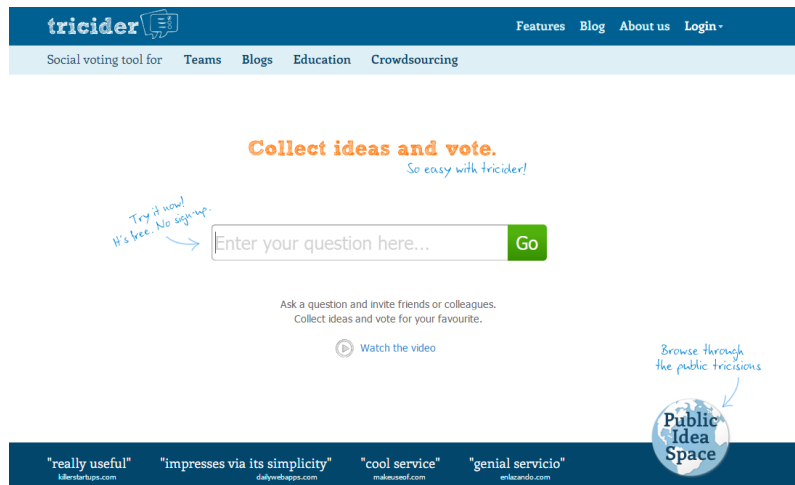
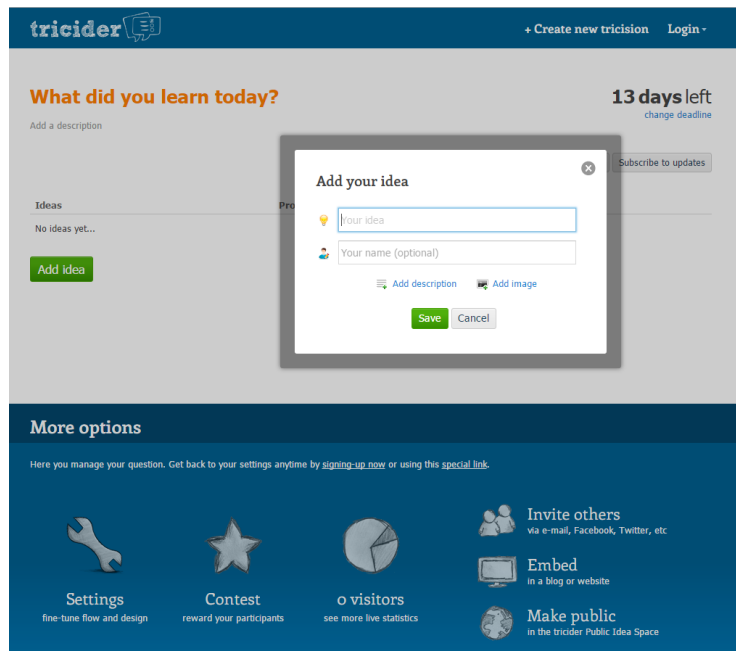


Tricider Screenshots:

1. Go to <https://www.tricider.com/>
2. Enter Question. Select “Go.”



3. Select “Invite and Share.”
4. Share URL with students.
5. Students select “Add idea” and type responses. Students enter their names (optional). Students can add descriptions or upload images (optional). Then select “Save.”



6. Students can discuss others’ responses by selecting “add argument” under Pros and Con, typing in a reply, and selecting the + for a pro or a – for a con, and students can vote for best responses.
