Face-to-Face Workshop Requirements

- There must be one device (i.e., PC, laptop, Chromebook) for every individual registered in a workshop.
- The site's network and bandwidth must be open and of sufficient speed to allow all registrants access to workshop dependent apps, content, and Web sites at the same time.
- All devices must have a current, up-to-date browser version installed (i.e., Chrome, Explorer, Edge, Firefox, Safari) and all other applications as applicable to the individual workshop.
- The trainer must be able to use the teacher station or connect their own device to the site network and LCD projector. There should be a screen for class viewing.
- Ten (10) participants must be registered fourteen (14) days business days prior to the workshop date.

Online Workshop Requirements

- Smart device with current, up-to-date browser (i.e., Chrome, Edge, Explorer, Firefox, Safari) and/or appropriate apps or plugins (see workshop description).
- Internet connection must be of sufficient bandwidth to support audio and video.
- Device speaker or headphones with volume control.
- Optional: microphone with mute button/setting.
